

Rotary Technology Tournament

Some Rotary Clubs and Districts run Rotary Technology Tournament annually, usually taking place in a large school or civic hall.

Rotary Technology Tournament provides an opportunity for students to use team-building skills in solving a design and technology problem, as well as to practice oral, written and graphical communications skills.

The Tournament is usually a one-day event for teams of 4 students from local schools and colleges who undertake a previously unseen challenge against the clock of a design, build and test nature. Teams can enter at basic, intermediate or advanced levels.

The task is consistent with the requirements of the national curriculum and its execution develops team building, communication skills, planning and time management, as well as solving a design and technology problem.

The day culminates in the testing session when teams can see the performance of competing designs and solutions.
